I. Tuition

1. Tuition Payment

A. Period: Jan. 12th(Tue) 2021 ~ Jan. 15th(Fri) 2021 09:00~16:00 [Regular Banking Hours]

B. How to Pay

1) Payment in Korea

- Designated Banks: KEB Hana Bank, Woori Bank and Nonghyup Bank(NH)
- Using Virtual Payment Account: Transfer money to one of personal accounts(KEB Hana Bank, Woori Bank and Nonghyup Bank(NH)) on the tuition bill (Making a deposit without a bankbook, internet banking, phone banking, CD/ATM, etc.)
 - ※ Applicants do not have to pay the tuition in applicant's name, and they are responsible for paying any additional bank fees.
- Using Credit Card: HANA Bank or Woori Bank card holders can visit the bank or pay through the bank's web site

2) Payment out of Korea[To provide separate information]

Outside Korea: Transfer money from abroad to CNU

- ▶ Sender's name must be identical to the student's name on passport.
- ▶ Account number will be Individually informed
- ▶ Students who transfer money from abroad must fill in and send the form below to grad@cnu.ac.kr immediately after transferring money.

- 1) For students unable to pay tuition all at once, paying in installments is possible
- 2) Period of Application: Jan. 6th(Wed) 2021 ~ Jan. 7th(Thu), 09:00~18:00

4) Payment Period

- Second Payment: Mar. 23rd(Tue) 2021 ~ Mar. 24th(Wed) 2021, 09:00-23:00
- How to Pay: Same as Section 1.-B. How to Pay

5) Amount of each Installment

- First Payment: the First Tuition Fee
- Second Payment: the Balance of the Total Tuition Fee

6) Notice

- If students do not pay within the above period, the installment payment will be canceled and you must pay all the remaining tuition within additional payment period.
- Confirmation of each installment payment will be sent to your mobile phone via text message. In addition, you can confirm your payments at your department's office or on CNU website.

E. Notice about Payments

- 1) Successful applicant who does not pay tuition within the tuition payment period will be excluded from the admission list.
- 2) Tuition should be paid during regular banking hours(09:00-16:00)
- 3) Successful applicants must submit their tuition bill at the bank even if on a full scholarship. If not, admission will be automatically rescinded.
- 4) After payment, please confirm if the payment has been successfully posted.

2. Notice of Payments

- A. An applicant who wants to renounce the enrollment at CNU after completing all of the registration procedures should submit a Registration Waiver Form and a Tuition Refund Request Form to the Office of International Affairs by Feb. 19th(Fri) 2021.
- B. CNU will refund tuition to the renouncer according to the Article 6 clause 2 of the University Tuition Rules.

II. Additional Documents (if relevant)

1. Diploma/Graduation(Degree) Certificate

A. Applicants who graduated from a university in Korea

Applicants who submitted a certificate of expected degree or completion must submit their official graduation certificate(diploma).

B. Applicants who graduated from a university outside of Korea

Applicants who did not submit an original graduation certificate either notarized by the embassy or by apostille must submit their original official graduation certificate(diploma) and transcript which have been notarized by the embassy or by apostille.

※ Applicants who graduated from an university in China must submit their Credentials Report or Online Verification Report of Higher Education Qualification Certificate after downloading from China Academic Degree & Graduate Education Development Center (<http://www.cdgd.edu.cn> or <http://www.chsi.com.cn>)

- Applicants who graduated from a university in Korea: Mar. 2nd(Tue) 2021 ~ Mar. 12th(Fri) 2021
- Applicants who graduated from a university outside Korea: until Jan. 8th(Fri) 2021

※ Enrollment will be canceled if successful applicants do not submit above documents within designed period.

2. Application for a Student Card(Smart Card)

A. Period: from Mar. 2nd(Tue) 2021

B. Location: KEB Hana Bank of the First Student Hall(W-8)

C. Please bring your photo (3×4cm) and Identification card(passport or Alien Registration Card etc.)

※ The bank will utilize the photo that you submitted during the application procedure

D. Method: Details will be given after admission.

III. Course Registration

1. Date and Time: Feb. 1st(Mon) 2021 ~ Feb. 5th(Fri) 2021

2. How to Register: After reading the “Course Handbook(수강편람)” carefully and a consultation with their department office, successful applicants must register for their courses through the website(<http://cnuis.cnu.ac.kr/>)

3. Notice

A. Successful applicants must register for their courses after a consultation with their department office within the above period, after paying the tuition.

B. Login to the website(<http://cnuis.cnu.ac.kr/>) with your ID(application number) and password (birthday-yyymmdd), and register for courses. After finishing the course registration, confirm the registered course.

C. Transfer student should be careful for the credit recognition when registering for course.

※ Student must comply with the scheduled dates and check the notice(required documents e.g. TB test result, uploading a photo etc.) on the dormitory web site(<http://dorm.cnu.ac.kr>) concerning details for living in the dormitory.

※ After Feb. 28th(Sun) 2021, students can move in only during weekdays from 14:00-18:00, and moving in on weekends is not permitted.

2. Duration of stay: Spring semester, 2021

※ An additional application is required to live in the dormitory for summer vacation and the Fall semester, 2021.

3. Dormitory Application and Announcement

A. Only students who applied for the dormitory during the admission application period are entitled to be selected for living in the dormitory.

※ Students who did not apply for the dormitory during the application period are not qualified.

 - 1) Choosing breakfast or lunch is mandatory.
 - 2) Students who choose breakfast can buy separate meal tickets for lunch.
- ※ Students choose between TYPE 2~4 can use allocated meals for any meal(breakfast, lunch and dinner) on weekends.
- ※ Students can use the dormitory restaurant by purchasing additional meal tickets after using up all of your meals on weekends.
- ※ Except for the residents living in rooms for the married, and building 12 and 13, selecting at least one meal plan is mandatory. If residents want separate payment of meal, he or she should make inquiries to the restaurant(☎+82-42-829-4026).

VI. Insurance

1. Every International student must have insurance according to Korean government regulations
 - A student currently qualified as a local subscriber of National Health Insurance, but who does not pay the insurance premium in advance, will lose eligibility and cannot re-enroll into the program. Only for the student can join the private health insurance.
2. Information on the National Health Insurance Scheme of the Republic of Korea for Foreigners
 - A. If a foreigner resides in the Republic of Korea for six months or more, he or she will be compulsorily subscribed to the local subscriber scheme of the National Health Insurance starting from July 16, 2019, and he or she will receive the same insurance payment benefits as citizens of the Republic of Korea.
 - B. Those subject to enrollment
 - Those who are not yet enrolled in the National Health Insurance of the Republic of Korea among those who have resided in Korea for six months or more.
 - Marriage migrants (F-6) are subject to subscription as of entry date into the country (if your alien registration took place later than the date of entry, then from the date of registration)
 - All foreigners except for those with A (diplomat), B (tourist), C (short-term), and G1 (miscellaneous) visas
 - Foreign students studying in Korea on D2 (student) or D4 (general trainee) visas are deferred from the compulsory enrollment (until February 28, 2021).
 - A student currently qualified as a local subscriber, but who does not pay the insurance premium in advance, will lose eligibility and cannot re-enroll into the program. However, the student will be allowed to enroll as an insured employee.
 - C. Enrollment process: Processed uniformly by the National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) without any separate reporting procedure
 - ※ If changing and reporting the place of residence at a registration government office, the applicant must report the detailed address precisely, such as the apartment or house number, so as not to incur complications from the mis-delivery of mail.
