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I Tuition

1. Tuition Payment

A. Period: July. 9.(Tue) ~ July. 12(Fri) 2024 09:00~16:00 [Regular Banking Hours]

B. How to Pay

1) Payment in Korea

- Designated Banks: Any Hana Bank, Woori Bank
- Using Virtual Payment Account: Transfer money to one of personal accounts(Hana Bank or Woori Bank) on the tuition bill (Making a deposit without a bankbook, internet banking, phone banking, CD/ATM, etc.)
- ※ Applicants do not have to pay the tuition in applicant's name and students are responsible for paying any additional bank fees
- Using Credit Card: HANA Bank or Woori Bank card holders can visit the bank or pay through the bank's web site

2) Payment out of Korea[To provide separate information]

- Using Alipay or Unionpay
 - Payment by Alipay or Union Pay (Union Pay Card issued overseas), respectively, using Hana Bank's unique account information for each student specified in the tuition payment notice.
- Outside Korea: Transfer money from abroad to CNU
 - ▶ Sender's name must be identical to the student's name on passport
 - ▶ Account number will be Individually informed
 - ▶ Students who transfer money from abroad must fill in and send the form below to okcnu@cnu.ac.kr immediately after transferring money.

- * When paying tuition, add a bank service fee for 100 USD.
- * Tuition paid in excess is refundable.

C. Printing the Tuition Bill

- 1) Period: Accessible from July. 5(Fri) 2024 10:00~
- 2) CNU web site(<http://plus.cnu.ac.kr>)→대학생활→학생민원서비스→"신입생 등록금고지서 출력 (<http://cnuis.cnu.ac.kr/EntUrgNotiQ.jsp>)"
- 3) Password: Date of Birth(yyyymmdd)

D. Notice about Payments

- 1) If the successful applicant does not pay tuition within the tuition payment period, he or she will be excluded from the admission list
- 2) Tuition should be paid during regular banking hours(09:00~16:00).
- 3) Successful applicants must submit their tuition bill at the bank even if on a full scholarship. If not, admission will be automatically rescinded
- 4) After payment, please confirm that the payment has been successfully posted
- 5) Even if the tuition is paid, if there is a change in the final amount, additional payment occurs after admission.
 - ※ Confirm the status of your tuition payment by checking "등록금고지서 출력" on CNU web site (<http://www.cnu.ac.kr>)
 - ※ Please call the Office of Financial Affairs(☎+82-42-821-5133) if problem arises
 - ※ Based on the revised guidelines for issuance of visa and management of stay for foreign students by the Ministry of Justice, foreign students are not allowed to pay tuition fees in installments.

2. Notice of Payments

- A. An applicant who wants to renounce his or her enrollment at CNU after completing all of the registration procedures should submit a Registration Waiver Form and a Tuition Refund Request Form to the Office of International Affairs no later than by October 23.(Fri) 2024.
- B. CNU will refund tuition to the renouncer for predetermined conditions, which is in accordance with the second clause of Article 6 in the Rules of University Tuition.

II Documents to be Submitted by Successful Applicants

1. Diploma/Graduation(Degree) Certificate

A. Applicants who graduated from a university in Korea

Applicants who submitted a certificate of expected degree or completion must submit their official graduation certificate(diploma) and transcript by February 28(Wed) 2024 to Office of International Affairs(Room 206).

B. Applicants who graduated from a university outside of Korea

Applicants who did not submit an official graduation certificate either notarized by the embassy or by apostille, and those applying for an extension or change of a domestic stay visa must submit their original official graduation certificate(diploma) and transcript, which have been notarized by the embassy or by apostille.

*Applicants who graduated from an university in China must submit their Credentials Report or Online Verification Reprot of Higher Education Qualification Certificate after downloading (<http://www.cdgc.edu.cn> or <http://www.chsi.com.cn>)

* Even if you have already submitted an apostille or consular authentication, you may need to obtain reissued apostille or consular authentication based on the guidelines for visa issuance

C. Where and when to submit: Office of International Affairs(E1-1) Room 206

- Applicants who graduated from a university in Korea: **until September. 4(Wed) 2024**
- Applicants who graduated from a university outside Korea: **Individual guidance will be provided via email**

* Enrollment will be canceled if successful applicants do not submit the above documents within designed period.

2. Application for a Student Card(Smart Card)

A. Period: from September. 16(Mon) 2024

B. Location: KEB Hana Bank of the First Student Hall (1학생회관 W-8)

C. Please bring your photo(3×4cm), Identification card(passport or Alien Registration Card etc.)

D. Method: Detailed information will be provided after admission.

* The bank will utilize the photo that you submitted during the application procedure

III Course Registration

1. Date and Time: October. 5(Mon.) ~ October. 9(Fri.), 2024

2. How to Register

After reading the“Course Handbook(수강편람)” carefully and having a consultation with their department office, successful applicants must register for their courses through the web site (<http://sugang.cnu.ac.kr/>) (☎+82-42-821-5042)

3. Notice

A. Successful applicants must register for their courses after a consultation with their department office within the above period, after paying the tuition

B. Login to the web site(<http://cnuis.cnu.ac.kr/>) with your ID(application number) and password(birthday-YYMMDD) and register for courses. After finishing the course registration, confirm the registered course.

C. Transfer student should be careful for the credit recognition when registering course.

V Dormitory Guide

1. Expected Move-in date: October. 31(Sat) ~ September. 1(Sun) 2024, 09:00~15:00

A. Student must comply with the scheduled dates and check the notice(required documents e.g., uploading a photo etc.) on the dormitory web site(<http://dorm.cnu.ac.kr>) concerning details for living in the dormitory

B. After September. 1(Sun) 2024, students can move in only during weekdays from 09:00~18:00. However, the moving in procedure is not permitted in lunchtime(12:00~13:00) and on weekends(including the national holidays).

C. Permission is not granted unless the submission documentation procedure stated in the announcement of precautions has been completed.

2. Duration of stay: Fall semester, 2024

A. An additional application is required to live in the dormitory for winter vacation and

the Spring semester.

B. Please check the notice as there are no other applications for extension.

3. Dormitory Application and Announcement

A. Only students who applied for the dormitory during the admission application period are entitled to be selected for living in the dormitory.

※ Students who did not apply for the dormitory during the application period are not qualified.

B. Expected date of announcement for residence list: July 23(Tue.) 2024, 14:00 (tentative)

※ Result will be notified in the dormitory web site, and every new resident should be aware of “the Dormitory Notice for New Residents” which is located at the dormitory web site

1) Choosing breakfast or lunch is mandatory.

2) Students who choose breakfast can buy separate meal tickets for lunch.

※ Students choose between TYPE 2~4 can use allocated meals for any meal(breakfast, lunch and dinner) on weekends.

※ Students can use the dormitory restaurant by purchasing additional meal tickets after using up all of your meals on weekends.

※ Except for the residents living in rooms for the married, and building 12 and 13, selecting at least one meal plan is mandatory. If residents want separate payment of meal, he or she should make inquiries to the restaurant(☎+82-42-829-4026).

B. How to pay dormitory fees

4) If you submit a Residence Waiver Form by October. 30(Fri.), 2024 18:00, dormitory fees are fully refundable.
